ORIGIN

Rural Future Foundation (RFF) began in 2020 with the single-minded focus of empowering Rural India. COVID19 pandemic has affected lives and livelihoods across all segment but rural population has been severely affected. The pandemic has triggered a massive reverse migration from the urban to rural areas in large parts of the country. Many migrant families who trekked home under the most difficult circumstances would have both short and long-run effect. India has witnessed globalization, information technology and data technology revolution in last three decades but rural population didn't get much benefit of these revolution.



The main aim of Rural Future Foundation is to level the playing field by enabling rural population to leverage innovation and technology to grow and compete more effectively. Rural Future Foundation was registered as a Charitable Trust on December 17, 2020 in Delhi. To begin with, we as a foundation decided to focus on education and therefore came up with first rural library.' The foundation was launched first initiative on 14th August 2021.

Since then we have also started various community based initiatives to aware students in our intervention area through special days celebration, live webinar sessions on various topics related to livelihood, carrier counseling etc. for rural population. We have also started many activities for rural population to inclusive growth and opportunities. One clear aim in all our minds was to create significant impact through the foundation. While it has been only 3 years since we launched the foundation's activity, we have already created impressive progress in intervention village. We have had around 3,000 people visited our library, more than 100 students attended our webinars.

RFF has also conducted Rural Quiz Competition 2021 ,2022 and 2023 to develop a competitive exam aspiration in rural students . Around 1000 students from more than 10 villages in near by area participated into three group i.e. Class 7-8, 8-9 & 9-10.

The foundation envisioned to provide technology and information based innovative solutions to the challenges that affect the rural population in education, climate change and health. India, with the largest rural population in the world, is experiencing an increasing urban-rural divide. Thus, our focus is enabling them to be self-reliant and prevent migration to urban centers through all-round development by improving the living conditions of underserved citizens through technology and data driven decision making.

All that we have achieved and all that we plan to do over the next couple of years would not be possible without your encouragement and generous support. .We would like to thank each and every one of you wholeheartedly and hope for your continued support in the years to come.

World No Tobacco Day 2022



On May 31, 'World No Tobacco Day 2022' was celebrated in village Ekchari. The purpose of which is to make people aware and aware about the dangers of tobacco. So that they save themselves from it as well as prevent other people from it as well. On this occasion, Mr. Anuj Kumar of Rural Future Foundation, under the awareness program among rural students, told the students that how tobacco use is harmful to the body and advised not to use. A large number of students and students were present on this occasion.

The World Health Organization (WHO) has revealed new information on this year's 'World No Tobacco Day', taking steps to make the industry more accountable for the extent to which tobacco harms both the environment and human health. Every year the tobacco industry costs more than 8 million human lives in the world, consumes 600 million trees, 2 million hectares of land, 22 billion liters of water and 80 million tons of CO₂.

12 Prevalence, Awareness and Control of Hypertension: 2022



It has been established through various research that prevalence of hypertension in rural area is growing many fold and raised BP is the number one cause of preventable death worldwide.

Rural Future Foundation has emphasized the importance of BP measurement to diagnose hypertension on time in individuals, as in rural area significant number of population never checked their BP. We are conducting BP screening camp at our Field Operation Office in Ekchari Village for BP measurement and awareness on regular intervals. This initiative will not only help to increase public awareness, but also to collect the scientific evidence needed to help influence health policy. We have plan to include other non-communicable disease in near future and expand the reach.
